SuperZoo 2019 GroomTeam USA Sanctioned First-Time Competitor Information Sheet

Contest

Prior to all contests: Please arrive at the grooming stage 15 minutes before your contest check-in time. Once the contest ring is open, you may enter the ring and find your table and set-up your equipment. Each table will have a colored tag with your name, contestant number, contest name and the breed of your dog. Each division will have a different colored tag.

Assistants: You may bring an assistant to the show to help you with your dog and equipment, but they must exit the contest ring as soon as the contest starts and may not enter until the contest awards have been completed. All assistants <u>must</u> be registered to attend SuperZoo 2019. If they are not registered, they will not be let in.

Dogs that are being utilized for competitions are to be kept in one of the holding areas, near the stage (available during show hours), or in the Dog Holding Trailer (available 24 hours). No soft sided crates are allowed. You will be responsible for exercising, feeding, watering, cleaning-up after your dog.

Dogs for ONLY the Rescue Rodeo contest will be provided for you from our local rescue groups. Each dog will be assigned to each groomer randomly, so be prepared to groom any type of dog. If you are competing in any other contest, you must provide your own dog.

Competitors should only use non-toxic materials on their dogs. No hair color or accessories (except Mixed Salon) are allowed, except if you are competing in the Creative Styling Contest. You can request a list of safe non-toxic products at janelle@wpamail.org

Items provided for you: We will provide a grooming table, grooming arm, chair and electrical for you in the contest ring.

You must supply your own grooming loop, grooming equipment (clippers, scissors, combs, etc.) you feel you may need during while grooming your dog.

Beverages must be in spill proof containers.

Attire: Dress in the ring should be professional for both men and women. Shoes (preferably with non-skid soles) must be worn. "Flip flops" and other open-toed shoes are considered to be unsafe ring attire and will not be allowed. A grooming smock is required to be worn during competition. Consider the dog's color when choosing your attire. For example, black dogs do not show up well in photos if the competitor is wearing black or any other dark color.

Best First-Time Competitor Awards will be held on Wednesday, August 21 at 4:00pm at the Grooming Stage.

Best In Show awards ceremony dress code is "dressy/classy." Grooming attire or jeans/T-shirts will not be allowed. This dress code also applies to competitors' assistants. A show staff member will be appointed to represent the entry of any competitor who is inappropriately dressed for the Best In Show awards ceremony.

All prize winners must complete a W-9 form or International tax forms before payment will be made. If you win multiple awards, you only need to fill out the form once. Please hand your completed W-9 to a staff member by Thursday, August 22 by 3:00pm. United States and Canada winner checks will be mailed within 30 days of close of show. All checks must be cashed within 90 days of issue or they will be voided. All other winners will be paid on site at the contest table

on Thursday, August 22 after 10:00 am. Anyone not turning in Tax papers before the end of SuperZoo August 22, 2019 will forfeit their win money. For international winners WPA is required to withhold 30% of total prize money.

Spa/Bathing Area

We will have the following available for you in the bathing area:

Grooming Tables (folding type) with adjustable arms, electrical, dryers, Bathing tubs with shampoo and conditioners

You must bring your own towel for drying your dogs and your own grooming loop.

Please clean up after you are finished bathing your dog.

Access to the Spa area will be on a first come, first served basis and will be open for 24 hours.

Day Use Holding Area

This area will be located on the show floor near the stage. You must fill out one <u>Crate Card</u> per dog and one dog per crate. The crate card will have your contact information in case we need to get a hold of you. You are responsible for the care of your dogs and dogs cannot be kept on the show floor overnight.

24 Hour Dog Holding Unit

- The Mobile Unit, located outside the back of the exhibit hall, will be the dog holding facility.
- The Mobile Unit will be open starting Sunday, August 18, 2019 at 6pm and will close on Thursday, August 22, 2019 at 3pm.
- You will be responsible for the care of all dogs you bring; exercising, feeding, watering, and cleaning up after your dog.
- For each dog, you will need to provide a crate (no soft-sided crates allowed), dishes and food.
- This area will be manned 24 hours a day but you are responsible to exercise and care for your dogs.
- You will be asked to sign a release when leaving your dog. Please download and print all required forms. You will
 need one set of forms per dog. Please fill out, print and bring your forms to the Holding Room when dropping off
 your dog(s).
